<u>Update on ITN-Misuse for fishing toolkit from Sara Betry (VectorWorks) & ITN Repurposing consensus statement from Hannah Koenker (VectorWorks)</u>

- The ITN repurposing consensus statement: provides National Malaria Control/Elimination Programs (NMCPs) and implementing partners with clear recommendations and key messages on three categories of repurposing: beneficial repurposing, neutral repurposing, and misuse. The consensus statement provides guidance on preventing ITN misuse and repurposing ITN materials without reprisal.
- ITN-Misuse for fishing toolkit: The purpose of this toolkit to assist USAID Missions, donors, or implementing partners who think there may be a potential issue with ITN misuse for fishing in the country where they work and want to conduct a rapid assessment to inform their programs and contribute to the larger research base. The toolkit is comprised of seven parts: an initial stakeholder assessment guide, a flow chart representing the overall process of the research, expected results, and illustrative programmatic implications, followed by a research protocol, questionnaires, codebook analysis recommendations and an illustrative budget.

- Analysis is being conducted by AMF on whether to put next generation nets in one of the provinces of DRC in Sud-Ubangi in north west side of country
- AMF is figuring out what kind of monitoring could be done

- PR is World Vision. AMP provided TA in terms of planning
- In summary, despite number of challenges, distribution is going well. The previous campaign was very delayed. Here they are only about a week off. Distribution is almost completed in southern region.
- This week, the national taskforce is meeting in Lilongwe for lessons learned to improve quality of distribution in central and norther regions.
- There are a number of concerns as there is an apparent shortfall of nets. Seems like nets from AMF are fewer than had been expected. Districts had provided for a 10 per cent buffer, and AMF has only provided a 5 per cent buffer. Having to make adjustments as they go due to this shortfall, the extent of which is not known at this stage.
- Reverse logistics and redistribution of nets will need to be sorted out

- To respond to the current shortfall, measures are being put in place: the taskforce has planned not to distribute nets in an IRS district; not to distribute in Lilongwe to some of the higher wealth quintile districts of the capital; and to cap nets per HH to make sure there are enough nets to reach their targets.
- 10.9 million nets total are provided by AMF and GF, and out of these, 2 million of the GF nets are PBOs.
- PMI looked at a realistic monitoring plan to monitor PBO nets without complicating the distribution and its schedule
- Concerns include that some nets now have to be moved around which will disrupt the PBO patterns of distribution because of the shortfall which makes the monitoring more difficult
- Overall the campaign is proceeding and on track to complete before rains start.

- AMP provider has arrived in country to support process evaluation for Katsina State distribution
- Catholic Relief Services, with funding from the Global Fund, is implementing a mass campaign distribution of LLINs in Katsina State. The campaign in Katsina is being implemented by Society for Family Health (SFH).
- It is estimated that the campaign will reach a total population of 9 458 151. The LLIN need for Katsina was estimated at 5 025 650 based on household mobilisation data. To attain universal coverage 1 net for every 2 people will be issued to households' members (with rounding off for households with uneven members).
- Based on micro planning, 1,893 fixed and 153 satellite distribution points are allocated to serve the population in the 361 wards in the 34 Local Government Areas (LGAs) of the State.
- A technology-based system through a Cash and Asset Transfer (CAT) platform using Android phones is being employed to facilitate campaign process including household mobilization, distribution and monitoring, including end process surveys, to register and track beneficiaries, as well as monitor LLIN stock levels at the distribution points.
- The general objective of the AMP mission in Katsina State is to provide overall technical assistance while specifically undertaking a process evaluation for the LLIN campaign including:
- Monitor and evaluate the use of technology in LLIN campaign
- Review the LLIN campaign implementation strategy/model
- Provide strategies that can be used in the Katsina campaign based on lessons learnt in Ogun and Jigawa campaigns
- LLINs distribution activities completed:
 - o 4 956 333 LLINs distributed
 - This represents 98,5% net redemption (5 025 235 nets cards distributed during Household registration)
 - o This represents 105% of the LLINs estimated during microplanning (4 728 845)
 - o This represents 108% of LLINs estimated during microplanning (4 588 239)
 - State supervisors' reports and discussions with different partners indicate that there are settlements missed during household registration.
- The end process evaluation two days after the LLINs distribution and was completed using the CAT strategy (mobile devices).
- Synchronization of end process data
- Final results from the end process evaluation was not yet available
- Post distribution communications ongoing: radio based and community sensitisation activities focusing on hang up and use messages
- Preparation for debriefing meetings by the CIT team with consultant inputs
- Face to face interviews with partners for the process evaluation exercise: DPs/wards, LGAs teams, State and SST.
- Challenges:
 - Data from the end process evaluation not yet available
 - Data on the reverse
- 2019 campaign support: Need to update campaign guidelines for 2019 and prioritise microplanning for 2019
