- Discussion on Container Storage Guidance and Next Steps:

Determining what we want to propose to WHO/ PQT during 2019 Meeting. Introduction to the group from Steve Smith (CDC) presented by Jess Rockwood. – Storage container document is in draft finalized and needs to be professionalized and submitted to PQT and AMP partnership.

Overall discussion includes what is the effects on storage in high heat on insecticide. Overall the container storage document presents two sets of problems in the use of containers for discussion 1) Given the current uncertainties and challenges posed by storing LLINs in containers for longer periods what is the effect that this has on the integrity of the net , 2) given the high costs and difficulty to move containers what are alternative methods that might provide more cost saving and less impact of temperature/humidity on the nets. A set of recommendation has been developed for the WHO/PQT in collaboration with and the recommendations that are going to be proposed to the PQ Team. The document has gone under three rounds of review, two internal to the AMP working group and one within AMP respective organizations. The discussion now is what and where we want to take the guidance next and at what level do we feel that its complete.

Hannah and Steve explained steps to measure problem of insecticide degradation in nets and how to come up with this empirical value. There is the possibility of doing this via both small control studies, through generated data for DHS or MIS (Hannah), or potential in lab settings to get better control estimates. Second discussion points arose on changes to changes to temperature regulation for insecticides from WHO, the impact new nets will have on and if their temperature storage is different from standard pyrethroids, and

Update on January 16th AMP conference call:

- Conference call took place on January 16th between NMCP, Global Fund, LFA and AMP
- Country is working to plan and implement a three phased mass campaign
- Micro planning has been completed
- Distribution budget has been updated
- Phase 1 will cover 2 regions with approximately 824K LLINs and start in March 2019
- Phase 2 1 million LLINs will be distributed)
- Phase 3 will cover western region and 1.1 million LLINs will be distributed
- A total of 4.7 million LLINs will be distributed across the three phases. 69% of LLINs are already at the district level.

Ongoing issues:

- Cameroon is planning to implement its third campaign in 2019. It is planned to distribute 14,697,104 LLINs with standard PBO and LLINs to be distributed
- VectorLink is conducting a mission now in the North. Starting microplanning for that area.
- Microplanning to be done by end of the month (PMI funded operational costs)
- AMP TA going back in at the end of the month to support HH registration phase and lessons learned from phase 1
- Procurement of second part of government funded nets is not taking place for now. Might mean going into a 4th phase of distribution later

Update on January 16th AMP conference call:

- Campaign is moving along
- AMF has order 3.2 million LLINs and are looking at the issue of insecticide resistance
- Schedule for distribution is currently being revised

Ongoing issues:

- Analysis is being conducted by AMF on whether to put next generation nets in one of the provinces of DRC in Sud-Ubangi in north west side of country
- AMF is figuring out what kind of monitoring could be done
- The Global Fund is funding nets in this area of DRC
- PMI interest in doing some entomology studies on that region potentially
- AMF is planning to support LLIN distribution at the end of the 1st quarter of 2019 in a region in Equator Province with 1.6 million LLINs and during the 2nd quarter Sud Ubangi Province with 1.9 million LLINs for a total of 3.5 million LLINs followed by further regions in 2020.
- At this time AMF does not have funds to fill the entire LLIN gap but are working to cover those gaps that AMF can support.

- NMCP through the national task force for Malawi's mass campaign seeks assistance from **AMP to support with the lessons learnt session and final report writing** on the overall implementation of the mass campaign to be submitted to Global Fund and other key partners.

- AMP TA arrived in-country on Jan. 10th. The focus of support will be planning the 2019 campaign as a top up campaign
- To date TA providers have reviewed reports and planning documents / log tools.
- Current planning is to update the 2018 log plan and develop updated microplanning guidance
- Have revised the ToR of the Log. sub-committee to ensure expanded procurement from multiple partners
- There is a gap of approximately 300,000 ITNs
- Country is still finalizing implementation plan.
- Key issue is implementation arrangement so far for 2019 campaigns: do they maintain same implementation partners (Pakistani Red Crescent and WFP) or look at different configuration?

Update on January 16th AMP conference call:

- This is the 2nd week of AMP TA support to Uganda
- Currently working on revising the campaign log plan based on outcome of earlier distribution
- AMP TA provider feels TA should be more focused on distribution implementation then planning (focus of ToR for current AMP TA mission.
- Working is ongoing on macro quantification in collaboration with Uganda bureau for statistics. Are quantifying nets needs based on 1.8 plus 10% buffer.
- Country will conduct the campaign by wave.
- In 2019 will use a centralized log. system different from earlier decentralized system
- The ToR developed for AMP TA did not put sufficient emphasis on the need for log support. Log support was included under 'Any other business' but in reality should have been central to the ToR provided to AMP.
- Overall a lack of engagement of key MoH counterparts who have not been making themselves available to the AMP TA provider

Ongoing issues:

- Uganda recently completed a Universal Coverage Campaign (UCC) that has rolled out since 2016 in waves to cover the entire population of the country. The campaign was completed in 2018. In total, over 25 million ITNs, including over 5 million PBO nets, were distributed during the campaign. One of the areas identified as requiring technical assistance in the preparation for the next UCC was logistics and supply chain management in order to ensure that previous successes are reinforced and built upon and previous challenges are addressed and ameliorated in support of achieving the mass campaign objectives of universal coverage and use of ITNs, including high ITN accountability.

- Main objectives of the support include:
 - List of logistics aspects to be addressed for the upcoming campaign identified based on previous campaign successes and challenges
