**Ongoing issues:**

- Household registration gave a population of 27 031 965 inhabitants for a number of LLINs of 14 815 826
- There is a gap of 2 641 783 LLINs.
- During the CNO meeting of the campaign on May 24 a withdrawal scenario was proposed taking into account the LLINs available exclusively for the campaign. This scenario projected a withdrawal from households to receive three (03) LLINs, which represents the average size of households from the macro and micro-planning data
- They want to cap at 3 (no households will get less than 3) everywhere and have submitted this proposal to the Global Fund for approval
- This new scenario gives a gap of 611,190 LLINs, broken down as follows: 429,430 Ordinary; 133,440 PBO and 48,320 IG2.
- The new 611 190 LLIN gap is almost similar to that of micro-planning and could be filled by:
- Routine stock returns from areas where districts will no longer use regular LLINs for routine.
- Routine stock for PBO and IG2 nets acquired for the years 2019 and 2020 that will be available before the start of the campaign.

- Organization of a call between the PNL, VL and AMP
- Phase I: Littoral (1st phase), South, East and West:
- Training of health area supervisors on the distribution of LLINs, training of 2 days per session.

- During the transport of LLINs, WFP highlighted a number of 15 damaged bales, some of which have their LLINs affected.

**Update on June 12th AMP conference call:**

- Implementation and Logistics TA providers in-country – weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week’s call
- Plenary session held for the validation of the data collection tools, LLIN traceability, micro-plan template and the overall action plan for the campaign developed
- Meeting with the coordinator of the NMCP to follow up the memo to set up the National Coordinating Committee (CNC) for the campaign and the possibility of organizing the first meeting
- Review of the Terms of Reference and Budget for the 9 micro-planning workshops of the sub-prefectures
- Finalization of the preparation of the training of trainers workshop for the facilitation of sub-prefectural micro-plans: distribution of the facilitators on the three training sessions, re-examination of the presentations, preparation of the pre and post-test, reproduction of the tools and packing of training materials
- Closure on June 7, 2019 of the filing of the files of the partner NGOs for the implementation of the campaign
- Recruitment of implementing NGO partners still a challenge
- Security situation in some cities of RS 3 (sub-prefecture of Paoua) is challenging

**Ongoing issues:**

- Call took place on May 24<sup>th</sup> with AMP to finalise the 2020 campaign budget with the country
- Number of procured coupons in the budget have increased: it had been noted during the 2017 mass campaign that there were insufficient quantities of vouchers, probably in connection with the fact that they were distributed in polygamous households - hence the 30% increase in the budget to reflect this fact. Since this increases the budget by nearly 18 million FCFA, they will discuss today an alternative strategy to address this problem.

- Distribution sites to cover 600 households regardless of the environment (urban or rural). However, we must take into account exceptions related to the distance from a village to a main site or for specific sites (nomads, refugees, etc)
- Government has already transferred CFA 1,500,000,000 to support UNDP for the purchase of LLINs for the regions of N'Djamena and Barh El Gazal. The balance will be paid before December to supplement the purchase costs of LLINs and the operating costs.
- As a result, it can be ensured that the mass campaign will be taking place in 13 regions instead of the 11 included in the plan.
- First distribution planned for February - next AMP mission towards end of this year
- AMP is working at a distance to finalise its comments on the plan of action, communications and logistics plans.

**Update on June 12th AMP conference call:**

- Logistics TA providers in-country mission completed – weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week’s call

- However, there are delays in implementing some critical activities.
- For example, the planned micro-planning meetings to be carried out in S3 & S4 in January are in progress and will probably end in May 4, ie 04 months late

- Review and update of job aids for HH registration and distributors
- Preparation of the training workshop for trainers and supervisors at the central and departmental levels on household registration, voucher delivery, LLIN distribution, social mobilization and campaign monitoring / supervision
- Participation in the debriefing meeting of the microplanning teams with the PNLP and CRS staff.

- Evaluation methodology has been developed in collaboration with PMI, GF, Liverpool School, AMF, MoH
- Overall evaluation costs will be significantly less expensive than traditional evaluations.
- Distribution of next generate LLINs will start in Sept 2019.
- Will test prevalence of malaria at health facility level in advance of LLIN distribution and then test malaria prevalence post distribution.
- Will compare malaria prevalence in areas that received next generation LLINs to areas that received traditional LLINs.

**Update on June 12th AMP conference call:**

- Implementation and Logistics TA providers in-country – weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week’s call
- Madagascar completed a national campaign, distributing 13,129,000 nets in 106 of the 114 districts of the country.
- There were a number of successes, challenges and innovations in the campaign.
- The campaign had two separate strategies by funding partner (GF and PMI).
- Objective of the mission is to support planning, implementation and development of lessons learned and recommendations for the 2021 campaign to be annexed to the final campaign report
- Support revision of the agenda for the workshop that will take place in Antsirabe the week of June 17<sup>th</sup>.

**Update on June 12<sup>th</sup> AMP conference call:**

- Context is that we are in an “emergency” situation, both in terms of country context, but also in terms of ensuring we are showing action towards addressing issues raised by the OIG.
- Given the in-country context, it is unlikely that we can do anything that is “ideal”, but we need to focus on “quick and dirty” approaches to move as quickly forward as possible.
- AMP will develop a revised scope of work with a focus on the research issues that need to be addressed to collect the data needed to revise the communication planning within the shortest time possible. The focus for this phase will be to: (1) develop guidelines and questionnaires for rapid-implementation focus group discussions and key informant interviews, including some thoughts on where to focus efforts based on the ITN access:use analysis done by VectorWorks on the latest MIS data; and (2) develop some basic “better messaging” on the basis of work from other countries that could be incorporated into this campaign (to align with universal coverage objectives), as well as an idea of the channels that could be used for dissemination given the current situation in terms of access to media, social media, etc.
- For the PCE team, the priority will be on accessing the data from the LLIN tracking system and doing an analysis of that data that will show differences between states to allow for better targeting of communication interventions. This data, if analyzed and available, will go a long way towards understanding some of the other issues affecting LLIN access, use and maintenance behaviours.
- Based on the results of the qualitative work (that will provide more depth and information to explain the quantitative information), there may be a need for a second phase of work that is more concretely focused on the planning for upcoming LLIN distributions (both campaign and routine) in terms of strengthening communication and addressing issues arising/barriers identified.
- Given that the campaigns are likely to roll out when possible, it seems that it would be a good idea to review the budget being spent on communication activities during the campaigns and potentially re-orient those funds to post-distribution communication. Poorly implemented communication activities during the campaign are likely to be less value-for-money than a robust post-distribution communication approach that focuses on issues coming out of the qualitative work.
