- Call was held with EIWG to discuss synergies on issues of both working groups
- Minutes will be shared with AMP core group to present proposal on moving forward with issues.
- **Issues with retooling guidance on HH registration**
- Everyone acknowledges that there are problems with household registration (most of these problems are consistent across countries, though there may be a few outliers here and there).
- People have ideas for how to improve it, but we need to pull together those ideas (e.g. if you pay more, is it better; if you collect loads of data, is it better; if you outsource it, is it better; is it higher quality using people recruited from the community or people from outside the community; etc.) in order to be able to move the discussion forward.
- If we can identify some key operations research questions that need to be addressed around potential efficiencies and improvements in quality, we can then pitch these to different partners and donors and look to collect data on what actually works and what doesn’t.
- It is critical that AMP starts to get ahead of this issue
- We should identify key partners that we could pull together for a technical call on this specific issue to try to brainstorm some of the questions that need to be answered and identify a way forward.

**Ongoing issues:**

- Overall, the activities of the NMCP are being implemented in all districts of the country. Now in the third round of the Seasonal Malaria Chemoprevention (SMC) campaign from 18 to 21 September.
- Preparing for process evaluation mission: the more in-depth the interviews are, the more we will obtain relevant elements of analysis to enrich the report and in turn give better recommendations.
- Phase 2 is IG2 distribution
- Process evaluation ToRs have been finalised and shared with PNL
- AMP is also proposing an observation mission for the country team in Mali to be able to learn from the IG2 distribution in Burkina as they will be conducting their own distribution in 2020.
- Timing of BF to be aligned with Rwanda end of October

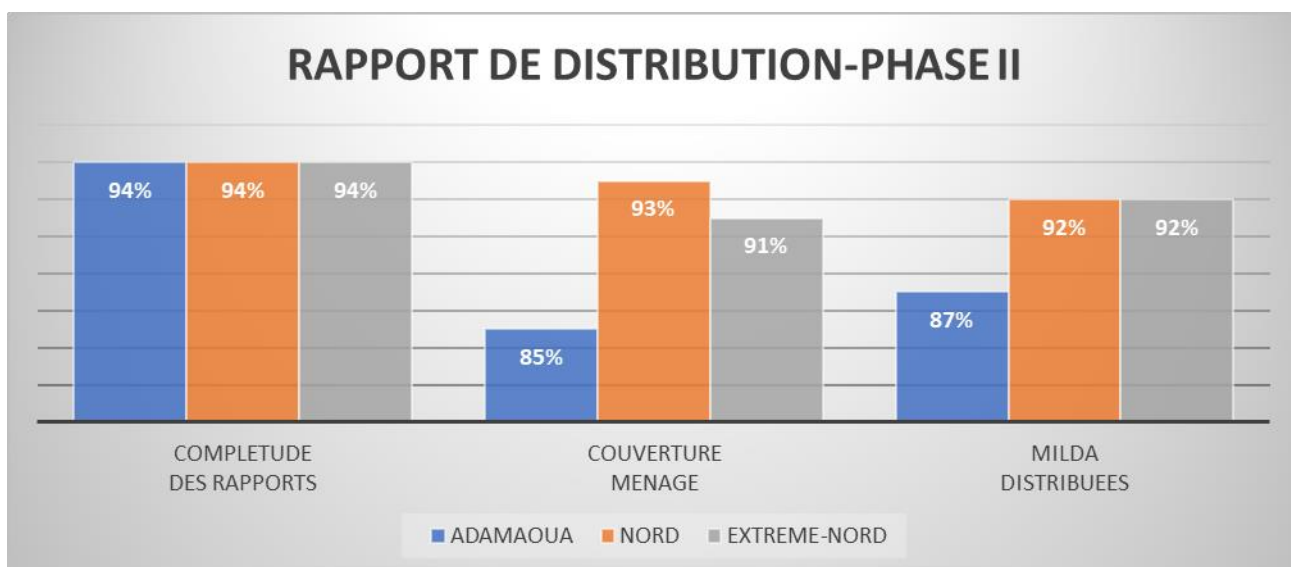
**Résultat de la distribution dans l'Extrême-Nord**

- La distribution des MILDA aux ménages dénombrés dans le cadre de la Campagne de distribution des MILDA avait été prévu, dans la région de l'Extrême-Nord, durant la période allant du 19-23 septembre 2019. Après une distribution des MILDA de 5 jours, il a été recommandé de prolonger la période de distribution de 2 jours pour un ratissage.
- Il est à souligner que cette première phase n'a concerné que 14 districts sur les 30 de la région.
- Les résultats provisoires à J5 se présentent de la manière suivante :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
  - 91% de couverture des ménages attendus.
  - 92% des MILDA distribuées.
- Durant les deux jours de ratissage, il a été recommandé de se rassurer que les équipes de distribution informent les ménages restants par téléphone et si possible avec l'appui du crieur.



**Résultat de la distribution dans le Nord et Adamaoua**

- Etant donné que certaines aires de santé des régions d’Adamaoua et du Nord ont démarré leur distribution en retard due à un retard d’acheminement des MILDA, dès le démarrage de ces aires de santé les résultats se présentent de la manière suivante en ce jour :
- La région de l’Adamaoua :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
  - 85% de couverture des ménages attendus.
  - 87% des MILDA distribuées.
- La région du Nord :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
  - 93% de couverture des ménages attendus.
  - 92% des MILDA distribuées.

**Update on September 25th AMP conference call:**

- Meetings ongoing with DMC, IHN, IFRC and PRCS to discuss:
  - Finalisation of agreement and contract between IFRC, DMC and IHN;
  - Adjustments to Red Rose;
  - Funding mechanisms pending the signature of the contract;
  - Security compromised areas and No Objection Certificate (NOC) applications – To note that the team will wait for a response from all 9 NOC requests, before starting implementation in Tribal Districts. This could further delay the implementation of the activity in the Tribal Districts. No NOC will mean no implementation in the said areas.
- Meeting with SBCC officers from DMC and IHN.
  - Delay in signing of contract means that many SBCC activities have been curtailed. Eg. Although advocacy sessions / launching ceremonies had been planned at the provincial levels, these were postponed several times as campaign timelines were pushed back.
  - Review of SBCC activities that can now be developed and implemented given short timelines and budgetary constraints.
- Working session with DMC, IHN, IFRC and PRCS regarding:
  - Review of microplanning templates, distribution points strategy and allocation of distribution teams;
  - Security compromised areas – in security compromised areas, PRCS to work with organisations who are already working in villages, and explore options for distributing nets to these households.

**Ongoing issues:**

- Matthieu A. AAWI - Programme National de Lutte contre le Paludisme (PNLP Togo) shared his experience on the call today of AMP mentoring exercise in Chad
- Presentation in English and French attached to the minutes of this week's call
- A new approach to mentoring is possible within the framework of the UNOPS funding available under RBM and is being explored and was discussed in more detail for integration into the AMP workplan during the AMP core group meeting held in August 2019.
- The idea is to identify an NMCP representative with a specific skill set (e.g. electronic data collection) and have them join an AMP mission. This would allow the person to gain the experience of AMP and our approach to working, facilitate cross-country learning and exchange of experience.
- The UNOPS funding can cover travel and mission expenses on these types of country exchange missions.
- During the first half of 2019, it has been decided to test this approach and to include the current logistician from Togo to support the AMP mission focusing on logistics in Chad in April 2019.
- It is a capacity building process through practical training which will enable Togo to have their own expert in logistics for future use in advance of their planned 2020 campaign.
- The TA provider was trained during this mission by developing some of the macro planning documents that are required for Chad (and which can then be adapted to Togo) and was mentored by the AMP TA team lead who has both implementation and logistics capacity to build the logistician's skillset further.
- Going forward there is a need to consider whether some kind of a standard reporting format for this specific type of mission will be developed and what do we wish to learn from it.
