Country Updates

Updates provided during the call: Liberia, Pakistan, Togo, Mozambique, Sudan

Liberia

- Country team is finalizing campaign plan of action, budgets, and timelines
- Country still working on definition of communities / areas as rural and urban
- Revision of timelines will be done once strategy and budget finalized
- Upstream tracker and campaign tracker will be updated accordingly

Pakistan

- Tenders ongoing to procure materials, including PPEs, human resources and transportation
- Teams are working on training material

Togo

- Distribution is scheduled to take place on 22 October
- Total of 6.5 mln nets are planned to be distributed (4.5 mln MF 2 mln GF)
- Mix of PBO nets will be distributed (Permanent 3.0 and Permanent 2.0)

Mozambique

- After a long period of delays due to challenges with supply chain, the Niassa and Zambezia regions have finalized the distribution
- The campaign continues in remaining regions

Sudan

- Country is facing important challenges and consequent delays for planned distributions. Partners are getting increasingly worried
- A call has been organized to inform all stakeholders that the campaign might spill over to 2021. WHO informed country team that this delays is unacceptable and planned distributions should be finalized by the end of 2020
