- AMP TA mission has started on macroplanning and plan of action
- Weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- In 2017, Benin organized a mass campaign and the next one is programmed for 2020 (March-April)
- Some discussions on how to improve the mass distribution campaign of LLINs, on the quantification and specifications of LLINs have already taken place
- LLINs and PBOs are both planned.
- Two workshops are scheduled during the two weeks of the consultant's mission and both focusing on the macroplanning
- The first workshop will focus on:

- Review and update of the campaign protocol;
- Review and update the logistics plan;
- Review and update of the communication plan;
- Review and update of the monitoring and evaluation plan;
- Quantification of human resources and tools
- The budget.
- The second workshop will focus on the review of campaign tools.
- Benin is keen to introduce the use of technology (smartphone or PDA ...) when counting households and when distributing LLINs.
- Benin also wants to sub-contract some aspects of the campaign such as HH registration to improve the quality of the campaign, but all this is still under discussion.
- The country no longer wants to conduct campaigns in phases.

Update on April 10th AMP conference call:

- Burundi is planning distribution in 2020 of 6,978,428 nets to 12 million people (including 12% allowed buffer)
- UNDP is the GF PR in charge of managing the grant,
- NMCP (SR) is in charge of overall campaign implementation, and,
- Caritas (SR) is in charge of training and implementation at community level,
- UNDP has confirmed with the UNICEF procurement unit in Copenhagen a purchase of 6,531,828 nets financed by the GF. Of these 553,266 are PBO nets,
- PMI will provide 446,600 nets for the campaign and UNICEF another 153,000 LLINs.
- Following the initial AMP TA missions earlier in March, the Burundi NMCP and the national coordination committee have requested for support for the development of a communication plan for the 2020 LLIN mass campaign
- CRSPC has been working to put in place the TA to start end of April
- All further support from then on will need to be budgeted in the Global Fund grant through UNDP

- NMCP workshop this week in Mbalmayo for the NMCP Annual Review and Planning meeting: 2 VectorLink staff are present (COP and LLIN campaign manager) and will review the pros/cons of the potential options with NMCP team and partners present

- Sud Ubangi distribution currently planned for the fourth week of August
- Equateur distribution currently planned for early August

Ongoing issues:

- Guinea's last mass distribution campaign was in 2016. To sustain the gains achieved in the past, the Ministry of Health will implement nationwide in 2019 a mass LLIN replacement campaign to distribute LLINs in 8 regions, covering all of the country's 38 districts for an estimated population of 13 236 234 based on a projection from the 2014 census (using a 2,3% annual increase).
- LLIN quantification was established dividing the population by 1,8 to provide 1 net for every 2 people (allows rounding up for households with uneven population) and adding 20 % as a buffer stock.
- Guinea needs to procure 8,825,000 LLINs for the 2019 campaign.
- Different partners are supporting LLIN supply for the campaign as follows:
- Against Malaria Foundation 4,500,000 LLINs (1,000,000 to be confirmed for Phase 2),
- Global Fund 1,884,500 LLINs,
- PMI 871,218 LLINs,
- OMVS 600,000 LLINs, (Organisation for development of the Senegal river basin)
- and the Guinea government would supply the 837,000 LLIN gap for Conakry
- It was decided to diminish plastic waste by choosing to have nets without individual bags thus nets in bulk packaging conditioned in bales of 50 LLINs will be procured. They are scheduled for delivery in country in time for the distribution in 3 phases.
- Mission Objectives:
 - Provide technical advice related to mass campaign implementation to the Guinea national malaria control programme (NMCP) and partners with a particular focus on household registration, coupon allocation to beneficiaries and monitoring according to the campaign plan of action.
 - Identify obstacles and bottlenecks which could affect household registration and propose solutions to assure a smooth operation and validation of results
- Catholic Relief Services (CRS) as the Global Fund principal recipient (PR) and RTI-Stop Palu for PMI are implementing partners in support of the Guinea NMCP for the 2019 LLIN distribution campaign.

- Mission completed weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call.
- LLIN distribution approaches in Mali are though routine and mass campaign.
- In Mali, the campaign takes place from one region to another according to the availability of resources with a period of 3 years between the campaigns of the same region. - AMP mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- The NMCP of Sierra Leone is planning for a LLIN universal distribution campaign in 2020, targeting the total population of the country with approximately 4.6M nets.
- The current technical assistance is provided by AMP through RBM and IFRC on the country's request for the macro planning of the implementation of the campaign covering strategy and implementation, logistics and social and behavioural change communication (SBCC).
- The TA team has decided to shift the work plan and prioritize the budget due to the pressure on NMCP to place the order for the LLINs, ensuring that all non-net costs are covered.
- Procurement will take place through PPM for GF LLINs and through PSM for PMI LLINs. Once the budget has been finalized, decisions will need to be taken on the funding split and mechanisms for the operational costs.
 - 4,601,418 LLINs to be procured, 2 101 418 by GF and 2 500 000 by PMI
 - LLINs to be procured are all PBO (TBC)
 - Discussions are still going on breakdown of funding responsibilities by activities and districts for funding partners
 - Delivery strategy will be 85% of LLINs to the districts, with the 15% balance being held at two regional warehouses that will respectively serve the northwest and southeast districts of the country following results from the household registration.
 - The work on the budget update is guiding the review of all the main campaign activities, including coordination, microplanning, training, logistics, household registration, LLIN distribution and supervision and monitoring.
 - Logistics plan of action is still being reviewed addressing the new logistics delivery strategy and lessons learn from the previous campaign
 - Quantification complete for human resources needs. An adjustment has been applied to the fastest growing areas of the country in an effort to avoid a large budget discrepancy when microplanning takes place in January 2020.
- Timeline has been finalized and sent to NMCP for final additions and then validation. Key milestones include:

- Microplanning package with information to collect to be sent to DHMT on the second week of November 2019
- Microplanning at district level, including western area rural and urban, is planned for the second week of January 2020
- HHR is planned for 9 days starting on the first week of May 2020 (separation of HHR from LLIN distribution and management of data; decision has been taken to indicate on the voucher the number of the DPs assigned to the HH during the HHR activities)
- \circ $\;$ Distribution of LLINs in country is planned for the first week of June 2020
- Risk assessment and mitigation table drafted and finalized for inputs from logistics, communication and then finalization by NMCP and the National Task Force
- Budget is in process of finalization challenge due to doing budget prior to fully defining strategy, which has created a longer budget process (useful, but narrative documents will be developed outside the country as part of post-mission distance support)
- Challenges:
 - Household registration most likely to happen during the period of Ramadan
 - Changes to finance procedures around zero cash to districts will create new bottlenecks (mitigation possible with good planning)
 - New implementation arrangements and roles and responsibilities of different partners need to be defined more clearly
 - Large gap on operational costs may be able to be covered by DFID
