Update on April 17th AMP conference call:

- AMP TA mission has started on macroplanning and plan of action
- Weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- In 2017, Benin organized a mass campaign and the next one is programmed for 2020 (March-April)
- Some discussions on how to improve the mass distribution campaign of LLINs, on the quantification and specifications of LLINs have already taken place
- LLINs and PBOs are both planned.
- Two workshops are scheduled during the two weeks of the consultant's mission and both focusing on the macroplanning
- The first workshop will focus on:
 - Review and update of the campaign protocol;
 - Review and update the logistics plan;
 - Review and update of the communication plan;
 - Review and update of the monitoring and evaluation plan;
 - Quantification of human resources and tools
 - The budget.
- The second workshop will focus on the review of campaign tools.
- Benin is keen to introduce the use of technology (smartphone or PDA ...) when counting households and when distributing LLINs.
- Benin also wants to sub-contract some aspects of the campaign such as HH registration to improve the quality of the campaign, but all this is still under discussion.
- The country no longer wants to conduct campaigns in phases.
- Plan is to distribute in April of 2020

Update on April 17th AMP conference call:

- Call to touch base with NMCP on the campaign took place earlier this week
- Household registration:
 - Materials have been received in each of the districts.

- Districts are starting district-level trainings this week, followed by training of the household registration teams on 23 and 24. The two-day training for the registration teams is one day theory and one day practical.
- No World Malaria Day celebration being organized, so household registration will start on 25.
- No independent monitoring for quality control of the HHR as no budget for it. However, there are two national supervisors assigned to each region that will do a rapid survey for 6 of the 10 days of the HHR. The observations and information collected will be shared during the daily review meetings for quality improvements during the HHR.
- Advocacy and communication activities:
 - Advocacy meeting with central level + regional governors and MOH representatives will take place on the 23rd.
 - The Minister will organize a press conference on the 23rd also (radio, television, written press).
 - Although no funding for the lower level advocacy meetings, the coordination committee meetings will be used to undertake advocacy to ensure messages get to the district level.
 - Job aid for household registration teams was discussed and NMCP will try to see if there are funds to do just simple black and white photocopies so that the messages from the HHR teams are standardized and consistent.
- Communication about new nets:
 - Communication at high levels is done on the basis of the concrete research findings for the country related to resistance, which anyone can access (public information). The map of resistance is used as the basis for explaining why different products are being distributed where they are, as well as for explaining that standard nets still work. A question/answer document has been developed (see action points).
 - Discussed the issue of household perception that nets aren't working (no dead mosquitoes) and the potential for rumours to start from the household/community level. They will consider different types of messages that are less scientific than the resistance maps for household level communication.
- Logistics:
 - Most nets for phase 1 have arrived, but still two districts receiving deliveries.
 - The PBO nets that were in containers are in the process of being transferred to warehouses that have been rented.
 - Two-day logistics trainings have taken place and all the training sessions have continued to reinforce the importance of correct tracking for all nets received.
 - Daily reconciliation at distribution points to be reviewed given the one voucher = one HH strategy. Tools and approach from Mozambique to be translated and shared.
- Net gap:
 - It is expected that the gap in nets will be larger following the household registration than it is now. This is a common occurrence in Burkina when they do campaigns.
 - They expect that it is likely that they will have to set a cap on the number of nets based on the household registration data. They feel that as the inflating of the number of people in households is similar across the country (based on their experience), the cap should be applied equally to all districts. However, once they have the data, this point will be revisited.
- Insecure areas:
 - Security commission is part of the CMO and activities will take place if they have given a go-ahead. Currently, situation seems to be getting better and targets are not community members doing health activities. However, more difficult for central/regional MOH people to access these areas. The importance of reinforcing the role and autonomy of the superviseur de proximate to be able to take immediate decisions in these areas was discussed.

 - Burkina to send the questions and answers document for review
 - Burkina to send the documents for the rapid monitoring (internal) for review

Update on April 17th AMP conference call:

- Delayed submission to the Global Fund to take into account major issues
- Moving towards an electronic system - Need to update the plan of action accordingly
- Ongoing review of logistics plan and concerns about nets in urban areas
- Burundi is planning distribution in 2020 of 6,978,428 nets to 12 million people (including 12% allowed buffer)
- UNDP is the GF PR in charge of managing the grant,
- NMCP (SR) is in charge of overall campaign implementation, and,
- Caritas (SR) is in charge of training and implementation at community level,
- UNDP has confirmed with the UNICEF procurement unit in Copenhagen a purchase of 6,531,828 nets financed by the GF. Of these 553,266 are PBO nets,
- PMI will provide 446,600 nets for the campaign and UNICEF another 153,000 LLINs.

Update on April 17th AMP conference call:

- Transport contracts are getting resolved step by step
- DawaPlus nets to be sampled and then shipped, while testing is undertaken (not after testing). We are waiting for updated information on shipment/expected arrival dates.

- Further review of the timing of the campaign was recommended, including potential options to include between two cycles of SMC or be conducted in October (HH registration) and November (distribution) after peak malaria transmission season
- WFP and NMCP are looking at modalities to get nets moving for phase 1
- PSI through its role on the USAID Vector Link project and the USAID Impact Project is supporting both the LLIN campaign and SMC campaign in the Extreme North in Cameroon. Because of the delays in the campaign there will be overlap between the SMC campaign and the LLIN distribution - we are in a position to be able to monitor some of the operational efficiencies between the two campaigns – call held last week to discuss ongoing issue, concerns and lessons learned.
