- The U.S. President's Malaria Initiative (PMI) VectorLink Project will build the capacity of country governments to use epidemiological, entomological, and coverage data to support the optimal deployment of vector control tools within each country context while promoting gender equity in all facets of planning and implementation.

- The project will also implement and support social behavior change communication and mobilization activities to increase acceptance of vector control interventions.

- In Year One, the PMI VectorLink Project and the National Malaria Control Programs (NMCP) in Niger, Cameroon, and Burkina Faso requested support from PSI to assess routine LLIN distribution.

- Mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- Burkina Faso is planning a National campaign for 2019, 12,174,205 nets funded by GF for universal coverage in all 70 districts of the country.
- Due to insecticide resistance in certain areas of the country, three different type of nets will be distributed: standard (9,341,340), PBO (1,299,245) and G2 (1,533,620).
- Distribution is planned in two phases: 1st phase May25-29 for standard nets, 2nd phase 12-16 July for G2 and PBO nets.
- PNLP is lead organization and face of the campaign, while PADS is PR and PSM is providing technical support and financing part of the logistics trainings.
- PNLP will be implementing a new approach for micro-planning in order to improve on some of the weaknesses of the previous (2016) campaign.
- 17 districts (of 70) have already received standard and PBO nets.
- The major priority of the current mission is:
 - o Finalise the development of a template for micro-planning
 - Facilitate a ToT on micro-planning: 2 session of 2 days each, 83 participants in total
 - o Review and up-date the logistics plan of action (LPoA) in view of the changes in campaign implementation (multi products / multi phases) since the document was developed for the grant
 - Support the review/up-date/development of campaign logistics tools
- Alain Daudrumez January 16 to February 6
- Obtained postponing of the MP ToT by 2 days to allow for better preparation of all materials (ToT was initially planned for Monday 21st through Thursday 24th – re-scheduled now from Wednesday 23rd to Saturday 26th)
- Worked Friday 18th through Tuesday 22nd on development of MP template, simulation exercise, MP presentation and training agenda.
- Facilitate ToT from 23rd to 26th January.
- Start the review and up-date of the LPoA, and review / up-date of logistics tools.

- Malawi distributed 10, 957,058 LLINs at national level, covering all 29 districts from 24th September to 20th November 2018 respectively. The key achievements of the campaign included:
 - Nets getting to the intended beneficiaries
 - Health education done at most distribution sites including net hanging demonstration
 - Good management of different types of nets in the warehouses without mix up despite clustering of districts
- NMCP through the national task force for Malawi's mass campaign seeks assistance from AMP to support with the lessons learnt session and final report writing on the overall implementation of the mass campaign to be submitted to Global Fund and other key partners.
- AMP TA will work with the NMCP and partners to conduct an **in-depth discussion of how the campaign was done** looking at (what worked well what didn't, what needs to be improved for next campaign). All **lessons learnt will be documented and a final technical report will be submitted** to mark the completion of the overall implementation of the mass campaign distribution.

Update on January 23rd AMP conference call:

- Mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- After rolling out mass LLIN distribution campaigns since 2014 without updating the National Implementation Guidelines, and based on the lessons learned, experiences and innovations tried during

implementation, the NMEP and partners have determined that an updated document is required to guide all partners planning and implementing mass LLIN distribution in the country.

- In addition, the country is working to strengthen the quality of LLIN delivery through public-sector health facility routine services and has identified a gap in training materials.
- Marcy Erskine in Abuja January 13th January 24^{th,} 2019
- The general objective of the mission is to:
 - Update the National Implementation Guidelines for LLIN distribution campaigns
 - Update the training materials for ANC and EPI LLIN distribution
 - Develop a document outlining approaches for LLIN distribution in the COE states
 - Review and update the technical, demand creation and logistics tools and training materials
- During the first week of the mission, four days were spent on the review of the Implementation Guidelines and gaining consensus across partners around key aspects where variation has been seen in planning and implementation. It was agreed that the Implementation Guidelines will allow for flexibility to allow for different procedures and policies of funding partners and will be forward looking to include the possibility of states financing their own LLIN distribution campaigns. The fifth day of the first work focused on looking at potential flexibilities that may be required for COE contexts, using a case study to allow participants to look at the options, risks and means for mitigation. As the AMP COE guidance has recently been made available, it has been recommended by AMP that this document is annexed to the Implementation Guidelines while Nigeria gains more experience on what may be missing from the flexibilities covered in the COE guidance
- The second week commenced with a review of the draft routine training manual, with the different thematic areas (logistics, technical, M&E, SBCC) working in groups to review the sections relevant to their areas of expertise and provide inputs. Following the review of the ANC/EPI manual, work has continued on the Implementation Guidelines, including trying to align all partners on a single M&E framework and indicators.
- Time is the biggest challenge. The team has been regularly available, but the discussions more extensive than had been considered from the outset. There will be a need for continued work at a distance, or a follow up mission, to work through the mission deliverables that could not be met incountry.

- Mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- In 2018, the Directorate of Malaria Control (DOMC) and The Indus Hospital (TIH) in partnership with the World Food Programme (WFP) as funded by the Global Fund, distributed around 2.5m ITNs in 11 districts of Baluchistan, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK) and the Federally Administered Tribal Areas (FATA). The strategy adopted in the distribution of ITN was to achieve universal coverage with ITN in the targeted rural areas where the latest surveillance data revealed high malaria Endemicity. The beneficiaries targeted were distributed one ITN for every two persons capped at a maximum of three ITN per household. The Pakistan Red Crescent Society (PRCS) was engaged by the WFP as the key implementing partner to manage household registration and distribution processes. The logistics processes were managed by the WFP having logistics as their core competence.
- The purpose of the TA is to work with the DMC and IHN to compile the lessons learned, harmonize these into the macro planning for 2019 (plan of action and logistics plan of action, as well as communication and M&E aspects) and update the budget to align with the modified implementation approach.
- Expected outcomes:
 - Updated logistics plan of action, including all supporting annexes (macro storage and transport plans, etc.)
 - Logistics timeline, budget and risk assessment and mitigation plan for 2019

- Uganda recently completed a Universal Coverage Campaign (UCC) that has rolled out since 2016 in 6 waves to cover the entire population of the country. The campaign was completed in 2018. In total, over 26 million LLINs, including over 5.5 million PBO nets, were distributed during the campaign.
- Given the timing for the replacement of the LLINs that were distributed, Uganda's NMCP is beginning to update the plans from the previous campaign based on successes, challenges and lessons learned to improve on certain aspects the coming 2020 campaign.
- One of the areas identified as requiring technical assistance was logistics and supply chain management, in order to ensure that previous successes are reinforced and built upon and previous challenges are addressed in support of achieving the mass campaign objectives of universal coverage and use of LLINs. It was planned to begin the logistics planning in 2018 to ensure that quantification, procurement and delivery level decisions are taken early, to allow appropriate budgeting, and timely resource mobilization for operational gaps.
- Overall objective: to support the logistics sub-committee, the NMCP and the NCC with the review and modification of the logistics and supply chain management planning for the mass campaign
- Achievements: Quantification of LLINs for the 2020 campaign completed based on the following assumptions
 - > UBOS projected population for 2020
 - Projected population of refugees in country
 - > Total population/1.8
 - > 10% buffer
