- ITN macroquantification: the base quantification to ensure that ITNs procured will be sufficient to meet needs following the microplanning and household registration is a major concern for countries, where experience has demonstrated that the current WHO recommendation for quantification (population / 1.8), with or without the 10% contingency stock¹, underestimates needs for the campaign. Most countries find they procure insufficient quantities of ITNs, resulting in their applying caps that can affect achievement of the universal coverage objectives.
- In order to help countries and partners move for a change in global quantification parameters for ITN campaigns, AMP's MORE working group is requesting support from countries through the identification of a focal point within the NMCP to participate in the work on ITN macro quantification and share the key data (see below) for inclusion. It is ideal if this is the M&E focal point or someone with direct experience working with the campaign data.
- Once we hear from the country focal points, AMP's MORE group will convene a call to further clarify country concerns, then facilitate a discussion with partners and global policy makers to determine the next steps. In the meantime, the MORE group and other AMP partners are reviewing existing data from previous campaign reports and surveys to better understand the problems countries are facing.

Is there a role that PMI can play to help walk the country through this issue as there is some risk with this approach? PMI to organise a call with PMI Benin team to see how they can support

- Discussion taking place on what is going to happen around the electronic management system. Timelapse for procurement of devices is uncertain and need to align partners on what we are proposing to Benin.

Ongoing issues:

- Finished HH registration and waiting on final data
- The country does not set a cap at the start of the campaign. With no cap, we are just under 2.5 million nets short
- Next step is to figure out where the gaps are in terms of districts. Nearly all districts have over registered.
- Need to talk through quality control and fixing caps.
- New nets country: PNLP would prefer single strategy approach for whole country in terms of caps regardless of PBO study areas.
- Cannot fill the gap they have with the routine nets, so decisions need to be taken.
- First phase of distribution planned for mid-June and transport needs to start in next couple of weeks.

Update on May 15th AMP conference call:

- AMP mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- Cameroon is planning to implement its third campaign in 2019. It is planned to distribute 14,697,104
 LLINs with standard PBO and LLINs to be distributed. 10 931 571 Mosquito nets will be financed by the GF and 3 765 533 LLINs will be financed by the Cameroonian government.
- After a halt of the campaign due to the selection of the transporters, the work was relaunched by the negotiations with WFP. WFP has been able to interact with the PNLP and beyond it has been able to develop a transport plan, a budget and a timetable.
- For this week and next week, the TA will support the planning, implementation and supervision of the training of local supervisors, household registration teams and briefings.
- During the period from 13 to 14 May in each of the two regions of phase two, briefings were held.
- Trainings will be conducted from 14th to 16th May at the level of health areas targeting community supervisors and household registration teams.

- After these trainings, HH registration will follow for 10 days and covering two weekends for a period from May 17 to May 26.
- At the beginning of this week radio spots began to be broadcast and continue until the end of the enumeration of the households.
- Encountered difficulties: Tools not yet routed (100%) at district level and health areas; Soundproof vehicles not yet guaranteed for the urban district of Ngaoundéré rural; The central and regional supervisor kit was not ready when we arrived.
- Extreme Nord campaign: call with PMI and VectorLink Tana nets still have not shipped contrary to hopeful message received some weeks ago. Still uncertainty about shipment date. Training dates may be shifting a bit learned that we should move ahead with training for data managers, logs and supervisors, but not yet with HH registration agents. This is because HH registration will shift from June to later in August possibly.
- Security concerns: contingency plans are under review by AMP

Update on May 15th AMP conference call:

- AMP mission ongoing weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- TA for 2019 targeting regions 1, 2 and 3 in 2 phases
- With support from AMP consultant, developed macro plan with the budget, and chronogram of all activities for 2019 finalised
- Planned that camping covers 39 sub prefectures, but based on last 2-year campaigns, realised that it will be hard to cover all districts. Idea is now to cover only 22 districts out of 39 and see if we can cover the rest next year
- Challenge is with the selection of implementing partners: local NGOs used to implement activities on ground: with the experience from last campaign, it was noted that local NGOs are very weak and not present in the regions where campaign is to be implemented. WV had to relaunch the recruitment process for new partners for implementation in the 22 districts
- Presentation and validation of the macro planning (population data, macro quantification of LLIN requirements, human, material and financial resources of the campaign) with WV and SLP staff
- Development and review with the WV / SLP team of 3 scenarios to cover the 39 sub-prefectures of Regions 1, 2 and 3 with the LLIN distribution campaign in 2019
- Participation in the review and validation of RDTs for the recruitment of NGO partners in the implementation of the LLIN distribution campaign in Health Regions 1, 2 and 3
- Participation in the mapping meeting of NGOs from health regions 1, 2 and 3

- Elaboration of the campaign logistics plan draft in health regions 1, 2 and 3, including the positioning, transport and LLIN storage macro plans and the milestone schedule for logistics operations.
- Participated in the 2019 Campaign Preparation Focus Meeting with the Chief of Staff of the Ministry of Health / WV / SLP
- Call was held Monday: coming in to end of this funding cycle concern is that there is not enough budget for the campaign. Discussion ongoing on whether microplanning should be done for all 3 regions even though one region will spill over to 2020 for distribution.
- Need to look at CAR as not just one country as so different from one region to another.
- Region 3 is the most insecure.

Update on May 15th AMP conference call:

- AMP mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- The approach chosen for Senegal's 2019 campaign is to conduct a national distribution campaign covering all regions of the country.
- This campaign is organized synchronously with The Gambia as part of the implementation of the Senegalese initiative for cross-border fight against malaria supported by the GF.
- This initiative, the first experience of its kind, responds to the dynamics of elimination of malaria at the sub-regional scale.
- The month of April was characterized by the census of households for the first-phase regions including cross-border to The Gambia.
- The transport of LLINs to districts in the Phase 1 regions has been completed.
- The gap that emerged after validation is: 271,250 LLINs. The distribution being scheduled for May 22, 2019 the big challenge so far is the supply of LLINs to districts, health post and distribution site on time with good traceability
- To fill the gap, using routine nets and provide to districts where there are gaps.
- Data collection in two phases : DHS 2 to start off with as an experimental phase. Gave at central level the results of 93% of final data but some inconsistencies
- For phase 2, will use DHS 2 but making tweeks based on lessons learned from phase 1- tablets were not available in districts for phase 1.
