Update on May 16th AMP conference call:

- Sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- Cameroon is planning to implement its third mass LLIN distribution campaign in 2019.

- Plan to distribute 14,697,104 LLINs (PBO and standard LLINs).
- 10 931 571 mosquito nets will be financed by the Global Fund and 3 765 533 LLINs will be financed by the Cameroonian government.
- AMP TA for implementation and logistics planning has arrived in country this week
- Before the arrival of the consultants, the NMCP had already worked on some elements of macroplanning. The team had already worked on the macro budget during the concept note development, the chronogram of the campaign, has already quantified the need for mosquito nets and their distribution by region and decided to lead the campaign in three phases.
- The team has also already placed the request for the LLIN purchase order
- Prior to the arrival of the consultants, the NMCP had shared some of the past and new campaign materials with the consultants.
- The TA providers will focus this mission on the following elements.
 - o Campaign plan of action
 - o Logistics plan of action
 - o Macro quantification
 - o Review of campaign timelines
 - o Budget review
 - o Review and revise past campaign materials
- The campaign is planned to take place in 3 phases:
 - o Phase 1: Regions: Est, Nord-Ouest, Ouest, Sud, Sud-Ouest - total 4.658.369 LLINs. Distribution planned from 15 February 2019
 - o Phase 2: Regions: Adamaoua, Extreme-Nord, Nord - total 5.111.288 LLINs Distribution planned from 15 May 2019
 - o Phase 3: Regions: Littoral and Centre: 4.927.447 LLINs. Distribution planned from 15 August 2019
- Ongoing discussion on the Household registration plans include the following topics:
 - o Paired teams for the activity
 - o Number of days for HH registration
 - o Vouchers
 - o Marking houses
 - o Rapid HH assessment for monitoring
- Need to look at specific strategies for urban areas

Update on May 16th AMP conference call:

- Weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- AMP consultant in country: Jean Marc Grégoire from April 20 to May 18, 2018
- Ogun State is organising with funding from the Global Fund through Catholic Relief Services a mass campaign distribution of Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs) for an estimated total population of 5,657,526 people.
- To attain universal coverage by issuing 1 net for every 2 people rounding up in the case of an uneven number of household members, quantification of LLINs need for Ogun was estimated using the projected population for 2018 (from the 2006 census) divided by 1.8 (in line with WHO recommendations).
- With a 10 % buffer over estimated needs agreed upon because of the last national census was over 10 years in the past, 3,363,654 LLINs were procured for distribution to the estimated population.
- The aim of the process evaluation for the LLIN Campaign in Ogun State is to gain insights into the roll out of the campaign against the developed timeline while piloting a new technology which facilitates household mobilization, asset transfer and payments of campaign personnel. The process evaluation also seeks to understand what phases of activity could be improved upon for future campaigns in Nigeria.
- The process evaluation will specifically look at the different aspects of campaign planning and implementation including:
 - ✓ Monitor and evaluate the use of technology in LLIN campaign (during training, household mobilization, LLIN distribution and LLIN stock management at DPs)
 - ✓ Review the LLIN campaign implementation strategy/model for Ogun State

- ✓ Review and recommend improvement on end process evaluation questionnaire
- ✓ Share lessons and best practice from other countries
- ✓ Make recommendations for improving Campaign processes and outcomes
- ✓ Training of household mobilization teams
- In preparation for the Ogun household mobilisation process which was from April 14th to 23rd and the LLIN distribution at Distribution Points, training activities had already been realised as follows:
 - ✓ State TOT for State supervisors, state team, monitors MTs, and LGA team
 - ✓ LGA cascade training for ward supervisors and M&S
 - ✓ Training of independent monitors at state level
 - ✓ Orientation of Town Announcers at LGA level
 - ✓ Training of household mobilization teams
- Campaign activities implemented:
 - ✓ Consolidation, syncing and reconciliation of household (HH) data
 - ✓ Preparation of micro-positioning plan (24th April 2018)
 - ✓ Orientation of DP Conveyors and transportation of LLINs from LGAs to DPs

 - ✓ Lack of credit on devices, poor network resulted in some devices being unable to synchronize and data loss
 - ✓ Although ICT4D allowed for real time follow up of targeted end process evaluation and rapid reception of data, campaign management was unable to use the evaluation information due to delays in programming information processing
- Solutions :
 - ✓ ICT4D unit visited areas lacking network coverage to download information devices
 - ✓ Spare simcards to LGA coordinators to resolve device simcards having no more data credit
 - ✓ Recommendation to have better assessment of device performance and more device support capacity to reduce delays in using the technology

Update on May 16th AMP conference call:

- Ongoing implementation support to Pakistan for the month of May
- Sitrep attached to the minutes of this week’s call
- Directorate of Malaria Control (DMC), Pakistan has been distributing LLINs to achieve universal coverage in highest endemic districts (API>10) through the support of The Global Fund
- Since 2015, Pakistan has been distributing nets through periodic mass campaigns, while there has been simultaneous continuous distribution of LLINs through antenatal services (ANC), which aims to promote antenatal visits in targeted districts. As per Pakistan’s National Malaria Strategy 2015-2020, DMC seeks to increase access to LLINs to 80% among people living in high-risk malaria areas.
- In 2018, The Global Fund NFR (Malaria) Grant, Pakistan, will distribute approximately 3.1 million LLINs in 12 high malaria burden districts through a mass LLINs distribution Campaign.
- **Priorities of the TA mission:** Work with DMC and Indus Health Network (IHN) on:
 - Revising Distribution Strategic Plan 2018 – 2020;
 - Develop macro-plans for 2018 distribution;
 - Develop micro-plans for 2018 distribution; and
 - Discuss and review feasibility of introducing IT technology in the distribution.
- A working session was conducted with DoMC, IHN, WFP and PRCS to review and finalise the WFP Proposal.
- Discussions were held with DoMC, WFP and PRCS regarding the use of IT in the implementation of distribution campaign. (to be documented)
