#### Update on May 1st AMP conference call:

- SBCC support from AMP is ongoing weekly sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
  - The National Malaria Control Program of Burundi is in the course of organizing a universal coverage LLIN distribution campaign, scheduled to take place in the first quarter of 2020.
  - Priorities of the TA mission:
    - To support the NMCP in Burundi with the development of a communication plan for the campaign, including strategies for addressing challenges identified in the previous campaign
    - Support the NMCP in the finalization of key messages and channels of communication before, during and after the campaign, including visibility support
    - To support the NMCP in the finalization of communication tools (job aids for all phases of campaign for IPC, posters, flyers etc.) to be used during the campaign to promote behaviour change related to malaria
    - Support the NMCP in the development of a communication timeline for the LLIN campaign including timelines for all procedures for procurement and reproduction of media and materials
    - Support in the development of a draft advocacy plan and materials for validation
    - Support development of the communication parts of the campaign plan of action and in the training manual
- Activities accomplished to date include:
  - Review of the campaign plan of action (draft not finalized)
  - Review of 2020 campaign communication budget and national strategic plan

- Review of 2017 key messages and communication tools (posters, stickers)
- Review of key communication activities of 2017
- Key informant interviews
- Need to include some key activities in the communication budget for the upcoming campaign. These activities will increase the visibility of the key messages necessary to promote behaviour change.

#### Ongoing issues:

- Monitoring the effectiveness of new nets: ANC option being explored in Sud Ubangi DRC
- Briefing for AMP Call Participants was presented by AMF and Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine
- Brief summary of campaign plan provided: Sud Ubangi is one of the worst areas of DRC for resistance. PBO nets were decided upon as the right option. 50% PBOs and 50% standard nets to be distributed and see what the difference would be in terms of prevalence
- AMF is providing 900'000 Permanet 3s and 900'000 Permanet 2s.
- HH registration set for July using electronic devices and distribution planned in August
- Primary objective monitoring whether new nets are effective, at significantly lower cost than an RCT
- Secondary objective understand more about the challenges and opportunities for useful but low-cost monitoring of new nets
- Tertiary objective improve health data in Sud Ubangi
- Visiting health centres this week to understand how feasible it is.
- Collection and use of Ante Natal Clinic prevalence data from 16 Health Centres in 16 Zones
- Organisations contributing ideas and potentially providing resources Liverpool, PMI/CDC, AMF, GF, Imperial.
- PMI and Liverpool School have put together budgets for this stidy. AMF providing nets. GF willing to support.
- Would be great to do MIS alongside this, but no budget for that. Applying to DFID to get budget in place possibly. Use 24-month survey data (as doing now in Uganda) and add on ANC data to that if no MIS is possible.

- Project will start running before August prior to distribution and until funding is in place. Monitoring 3year use of nets over their lifetime ideally. Results on a monthly basis analysed in Liverpool and carry on for as long as it can be funded.
- Rotarians expressed interest on the call to provide financial contribution to the study.
