- The purpose is to get consolidated visibility on which countries are planning and implementing mass campaigns in what year and understanding more what is happening at national and sub national level, and collecting data on type of nets and estimated quantities.
- There is a value in having an understanding for the purposes of procurement, planning, visibility on what is going on where (including new nets and new products)
- PMI has been tracking some of that information internally but is keen to engage with other partners and donors, as well as countries and PRs to have a better understanding globally on what is going on.

- Number of HHs per day in plans not respected
- Fear of running out of coupons, but in the end, they didn't usually run out
- Analysis and treatment of data underway at central level some delay in validating data from the regions
- Meeting this week to present final data and do proposals on how they will adjust (gap: 2.6 mil net) –
 initially caps were going to be applied, but complications with distribution of IG2 nets and standard nets country wants same strategy adopted nationwide

- AMP mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- Cameroon is planning to implement its third campaign in 2019. It is planned to distribute 14,697,104
 LLINs with standard PBO and LLINs to be distributed. 10 931 571 Mosquito nets will be financed by the GF and 3 765 533 LLINs will be financed by the Cameroonian government.
- After a halt of the campaign due to the selection of the transporters, the work was relaunched by the negotiations with WFP. WFP has been able to interact with the PNLP and beyond it has been able to develop a transport plan, a budget and a timetable.
- Phase II-Adamaoua Region and Northern Region:
- Trainings of town criers, HH registration teams and proximity supervisors on the implementation of the household registration were carried out
- Counting of households and distribution of outstanding coupons
- Collection and capturing of daily data through the DHIS2
- Sharing data by area, district, and region to all supervisors at each level by WhatsApp daily.
- Communication activities ongoing through community radios and through national channels

- Supervision of training and enumeration of households by supervisory teams
- Agreement for a start of discussion with WFP for the transport of LLINs of the 2nd phase
- Payment of the actors for the training activities after submission of training reports and supporting documents
- Phase I: Littoral (1st phase), South, East and West
- Meeting between WFP and regional teams
- Meeting between WFP and the various selected carriers

- AMP mission ongoing sitrep attached to the minutes of this week's call
- The approach chosen for Senegal's 2019 campaign is to conduct a national distribution campaign covering all regions of the country.
- This campaign is organized synchronously with The Gambia as part of the implementation of the Senegalese initiative for cross-border fight against malaria supported by the GF.
- This initiative, the first experience of its kind, responds to the dynamics of elimination of malaria at the sub-regional scale.
- Validation of household census data for the first-phase and cross-border regions in the Gambia was done last week.
- This validation has meant a readjustment of the LLIN stockpiles and updated LLIN district transport
 plans at the health posts on the one hand and from the health posts to the distribution sites on the other
 hand.
- Districts with additional LLIN requirements received their nets
- Some were refueled from the central level (220,450 LLINs)
- There have been pre-positioned nets that were redeployed (13300 LLINs)
- A quantity has been taken from the leftover nets of the mini UC campaign (12 000 LLIN)
- And a loan has been made from routine (44,850 LLINs)
- 97% of health posts to date have pre-positioned their LLINs in their distribution sites
- The 3% represent health posts for which we have no information.
- The distribution will actually start on May 22 as agreed. Sokone District launched at the Betenty Island Health Post in the presence of the US Ambassador.
- Challenges:
- Distribution scheduled for May 22, 2019; the big challenge so far is communication. Border crossings have not yet received the communication tools that have arrived in the regions with the arrival of central supervisors.
- Cross-border posts in The Gambia did not participate in border post meetings with Senegalese posts;
 we have been able to catch up with the posts we have visited but are worried about the organization of the other posts which seems to have no information from their district.
