Toolkit and Training working group:

- 2 trainings are taking place this month (English and French) in Kenya
- The English language training took place last week, and the French language training is ongoing this week and will be completed on Friday.
- 9 anglophone countries participated in last week's training, with 3 representatives for each country with profiles focused on logistics management, M&E and SBCC. All countries were from sub-Saharan Africa with the exception of Pakistan who was also present, and all participating countries are conducting mass or continuous campaigns in 2019 and 2020. This week, a total of 10 countries are participating in the French language training.

- Topics that are being covered in the trainings include quantification, procurement and macro-planning, logistics, continuous distribution, household registration, microplanning, communication, budgeting, M&E, data management, leadership and management.
- The curriculum is very interactive where we are working on different country scenarios for campaign planning with group work in the participants' areas of expertise (log, M&E and comms).
- Each of the trainings are four days in length
- The revised AMP Toolkit and the Continuous Distribution Toolkit are being used as guides to the content in the technical sessions. Using the toolkits as a road map for the trainings are helping to orient the NMCPs and implementing partners on the content and resources available from the partnership.
- The trainings so far are fostering good exchanges of country experiences in mass and continuous distribution between the different countries present.
- The training days are very full, with evening sessions also scheduled on specific topics such as planning of distribution in COEs and an introduction to the Commodity Management Audit tools for example.
- The training team will work on a final report and one pager from the trainings which we will aim to share across the partnership.
- New tools made available by AMP are being disseminated such as the newly published guidance on microplanning, the revised briefs on logistics and communications, the new guidelines and minimum data requirements etc.
- New Tools:
- We will present the newly available tools to the AMP partnership on some of our upcoming calls leading up to the end of the year. The future calls schedule will include the following topics:
- November 28 Hannah Koenker on the repurposing consensus statement
- December 5 Marcy/Alain (AMP) on the updated micro planning guidance from AMP
- December 12 Andrea/Hunter (JHU CCP) on the updated SBCC documents from AMP
- December 19 Marcy (AMP) on the COE guidance
- All these tools will be available on the AMP website in the next couple of days.
- One of the other things we are interested in gathering is to look at countries' payment systems to put together payment options for countries going forward – this issue will be brought forward within the AMP Country Support Working Group to gather lessons learned on behalf of the partnership.
- Same goes for lessons learned on electronic data collection methods.
- We've worked on some standard case study templates to collect information from countries and put some guidance together on these issues.

- Multi product campaign planned TA in this context looks like it's going to be crucial after the recent procurement information regarding the availability of G2 nets for distribution. Ongoing TA may be possible through the UNITAID next generation nets project as they have factored in AMP TA for support to countries that will be rolling out distribution of next generation products.
- TA request has moved within the UNOPS system and there will be a first mission planned before the end of the year in December
- Distribution is planned in June next year. Planning for HH registration in February and microplanning should take place before that.
- The objective of the TA is to support the PNLP in Burkina Faso with the finalization of the macro planning documents, the campaign timeline and the preparation of the documents for the microplanning exercise that will take place in advance of the campaign.
- The major deliverables will include
 - Updated macroplanning documents and campaign timeline
 - Final agendas for microplanning TOT and workshops The objective is to minimize the risk of a large gap in ITNs following the household registration through strengthening the microplanning part of the campaign. This was a problem that was identified in there last campaign, so trying not to make the same mistakes again!
 - Final M&E/logistics and communication microplanning templates
 - Draft document focused on considerations for communication planning for a multi-product campaign

- The Global Fund reached out to AMP last week to inform AMP that through the malaria GF grant (2018-2020), they will be covering the costs of the AMP TA to the amount of 100k USD, for support with the 2020 LLIN mass campaign.

Update on November 14th AMP conference call:

- Sitrep shared with the minutes of this week's call
- Cameroon is planning to implement its third campaign in 2019. It is planned to distribute 14,697,104
 LLINs with standard PBO and LLINs to be distributed
- Procurement through Wambo and PPM.
- 10 931 571nets will be financed by the GF and 3 765 533 LLINs will be financed by the Cameroonian government,
- When the consultants arrived, the campaign team had already drafted the first draft of the monitoring & evaluation, communication and security plans. With the GF, the PNLP team had already ordered certain quantities of LLINs to arrive for the first phase of distribution.
- Micro planning: the missions are composed of 2 groups of 4 people. They will supervise two regions each. The first two regions visited will be the Western and Southern regions for the period from November 19 to 23, and the Littoral and Eastern regions for the period from November 26 to 29
- Preparation are underway for receiving the LLINS: the contracts will be signed by the 16th at the latest for the southern regions. For the western and eastern regions steps are underway to finalize the contracts

- AMF is planning to support LLIN distribution at the end of the 1st quarter of 2019 in a region in Equator Province with 1.6 million LLINs and during the 2nd quarter Sud Ubangi Province with 1.9 million LLINs for a total of 3.5 million LLINs followed by further regions in 2020
- Negotiations were concluded by AMF this week with MoH signing agreement to receive total 11.8 million nets for 2019. Assuming it goes well in the first two provinces and after mid-term review in February, the next provinces will also be provided with nets in 2019.
- Looking at insecticide resistance data very carefully
- Extra expenses in purchasing PBO nets needs to be looked at carefully
- Resistance data in Sud Ubangi and Tanganika looks serious and is growing, so these areas would be prioritised for PBOs. Not ruling out other areas, but out of 5 provinces to be covered, these two look most vulnerable to IR. Decisions are not finalised.
- Next step is finalisation of the orders.

Ongoing issues:

- PR is World Vision. AMP provided TA in terms of planning
- In summary, despite number of challenges, distribution is going well. The previous campaign was very delayed. Here they are only about a week off. Distribution is almost completed in southern region.
- This week, the national taskforce is meeting in Lilongwe for lessons learned to improve quality of distribution in central and norther regions.
- There are a number of concerns as there is an apparent shortfall of nets. Seems like nets from AMF are fewer than had been expected. Districts had provided for a 10 per cent buffer, and AMF has only provided a 5 per cent buffer. Having to make adjustments as they go due to this shortfall, the extent of which is not known at this stage.
- Reverse logistics and redistribution of nets will need to be sorted out
- To respond to the current shortfall, measures are being put in place: the taskforce has planned not to distribute nets in an IRS district; not to distribute in Lilongwe to some of the higher wealth quintile districts of the capital; and to cap nets per HH to make sure there are enough nets to reach their targets.
- 10.9 million nets total are provided by AMF and GF, and out of these, 2 million of the GF nets are PBOs.
- PMI looked at a realistic monitoring plan to monitor PBO nets without complicating the distribution and its schedule
- Concerns include that some nets now have to be moved around which will disrupt the PBO patterns of distribution because of the shortfall which makes the monitoring more difficult
- Overall the campaign is proceeding and on track to complete before rains start.

Update on November 14th AMP conference call:

- AMP has completed the process evaluation for Katsina State distribution which has been shared with CRS and with the country
- The AMP TA provider is back in Abuja this week preparing for the next process evaluation of the Gombe State campaign – currently working out the movement of the consultant due to heightened security issues
- Gombe campaign planned to start on November 23rd. Completed social mobilization activities in the LGAs just a bit over microplanning targets in terms of population.
- Next steps are training of distribution point teams on logistics and micro logistics to distribution points
- As we approach the end of 2018, CRS Nigeria has started thinking about key areas for AMP support for the 2019 LLIN Campaigns as the contract for TA between AMP and CRS will be renewed in 2019.

- Some of the proposed areas of focus would be around a follow up to the CMA missions that took place in 2018 and how the roll out went with the new tools, whether other tools are required and whether a more detailed operational guideline is required to standardize the new approach to the CMAs
- Look at microplanning and ensuring alignment with the updated guidance around this activity, and particularly looking at strengthening the SBCC aspect of micro planning
- Updating the implementation guidelines (this is guite overdue)
- There has been discussion about doing an ITN scale up and CD training in Nigeria so we will follow up with the malaria technical team at the GF and see where we are with that
- The country is also keen to revise the Routine/Continuous Distribution Manual early next year and are hoping that AMP could support with this.
- We have received the timelines for the 2019 LLIN Campaigns. All the campaigns will be implemented using ICT4D, except Yobe State where there are severe security challenges and inconsistent network/internet connections.
