- Call was held with EIWG to discuss synergies on issues of both working groups
- Minutes will be shared with AMP core group to present proposal on moving forward with issues.
- Issues with retooling guidance on HH registration
- Everyone acknowledges that there are problems with household registration (most of these problems are consistent across countries, though there may be a few outliers here and there).
- People have ideas for how to improve it, but we need to pull together those ideas (e.g. if you pay more, is it better; if you collect loads of data, is it better; if you outsource it, is it better; is it higher quality using people recruited from the community or people from outside the community; etc.) in order to be able to move the discussion forward.
- If we can identify some key operations research questions that need to be addressed around potential efficiencies and improvements in quality, we can then pitch these to different partners and donors and look to collect data on what actually works and what doesn't.
- It is critical that AMP starts to get ahead of this issue
- We should identify key partners that we could pull together for a technical call on this specific issue to try to brainstorm some of the questions that need to be answered and identify a way forward.
- Quality control (rapid monitoring)

Update on October 2nd AMP conference call:

- Un draft de plan d'action est disponible. Les ateliers de microplanification étaient déjà organisés à notre arrivée, les fichiers de microplans sont disponibles mais, les synthèses ne sont pas encore finalisées pour une validation du budget; une demande de non objection est envoyée au FM par le PNUD pour toutes les activités planifiées dans l'immédiat pour ne pas compromettre le chronogramme.
- La production des outils de gestion est bien avancée, une visite prévue chez l'imprimeur ce jour 01er octobre par CARITAS pour envisager une livraison dans les prochains jours;
- Les Contrats CARITAS pour mise en œuvre communautaire sont transmis à toutes les ABC du pays ;
- Le paramétrage du DHIS 2 déjà été réalisé la semaine passée, mais le module de formation n'est pas encore élaboré et les codés d'accès non encore disponibles ;
- Le Changement de province pour la première phase a été évoqué par la directrice (suite à l'analyse de la livraison des MILDA) mais implications non négligeables semblent plaider en défaveur de cette option mais pas tout à fait évacuée (faisabilité à évaluer par PNILP et CARITAS);

- Pour le Système de paiement : nous avons posé la question à CARITAS en présence du PNILP et de Mr Samir du PNUD, il semble d'après la réponse de CARITAS que ce qui est décrit dans le plan d'action sera appliqué : liste des agents à récupérer et à enregistrer sur fichier excel par le PNLP et transmettre au PNUD pour paiement sur site par les agents de banques contractantes avec PNUD. Un enregistrement est décrit dans le plan sur smartphones, mais CARITAS semble se demander où sont ces smartphones (apparemment non encore acquis). Néanmoins, une session dédiée à ce volet est prévue pour après-demain on pourra davantage creuser et avoir un état final.
- L'Enquête rapide est décidée mais le protocole n'est pas encore élaboré, il a été demandé au PNLP d'y travailler. L'Institut des Statistiques et d'Études Économiques du Burundi (ISTEEBU) est retenue pour cette ER.


Résultat de la distribution dans l'Extrême-Nord

- La distribution des MILDA aux ménages dénombrés dans le cadre de la Campagne de distribution des MILDA avait été prévu, dans la région de l'Extrême-Nord, durant la période allant du 19-23 septembre 2019. Après une distribution des MILDA de 5 jours, il a été recommandé de prolonger la période de distribution de 2 jours pour un ratissage.
- Il est à souligner que cette première phase n'a concerné que 14 districts sur les 30 de la région.
- Les résultats provisoires à J5 se présentent de la manière suivante :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
 - o 91% de couverture des ménages attendus.
 - o 92% des MILDA distribuées.
- Durant les deux jours de ratissage, il a été recommandé de se rassurer que les équipes de distribution informent les ménages restants par téléphone et si possible avec l'appui du crieur.

Résultat de la distribution dans le Nord et Adamaoua

- Etant donné que certaines aires de santé des régions d'Adamaoua et du Nord ont démarré leur distribution en retard due à un retard d'acheminement des MILDA, dès le démarrage de ces aires de santé les résultats se présentent de la manière suivante en ce jour :
- La région de l'Adamaoua :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
 - o 85% de couverture des ménages attendus.
 - o 87% des MILDA distribuées.

- La région du Nord :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
 - o 93% de couverture des ménages attendus.
 - o 92% des MILDA distribuées.

- Participation in the daily coordination/review meeting with the 44 LGA Coordinators with presence of SMOH, NMEP, Technical, Logistic, Demand Creation and Finance teams; The meeting report on status of activities, discuss issues resolution and indicate/direct the support teams to LGAs in need;

- Identification and training of DP conveyors one DP per ward to ensure pre-positioning distribution on time and avoid loss of nets. Depending on size, some ward might need to have two (2) conveyors;
- Started (Sep 30) LLINs movement/micro positioning from LGAs to the 3160 DPs' warehouses planned for 5 days;
- Use of technology/CAT platform with geo-positioning confirms once more its efficiency optimising processes, reducing campaign schedule and making a great difference in having available data to inform timely management/operational decisions. The ICT4D Team is continuously improving data analysis and visibility as well as the reporting tools to facilitate activity implementation and inventory monitoring and control. New electronic Forms are designed as needed to closely control inventory movement and reverse logistic.
- The Kano campaign LGA Coordinators (one for each of the 44 LGAs) and the Master Trainers (159) to train, resolve and support in use of the technology, are two key coordination positions, exclusively hired/assigned for the day to day operation, are proving to be essential and critical to a close/continuous control, support and efficient campaign implementation.
- The distribution is planned to start on October 5th;
- Some LGA started micro positioning a day late and require to ensure the transport is done on time particularly for those with large number of DPs;
- A number of LGAs have change of personnel due to political interference/nomination and tensions among local actors between and with the implementation team. This require negotiation and conciliation effort and time which cause delays in activity implementation;
- Personnel replacement done in some LGAs following identification of weak individuals for DP supervisor;
- Use of technology can be difficult to comprehend and use by some participants;
- Few LGA experienced tension during training;
- Ensure LLIN security while at DPs warehouses;

- Security remains a challenging task; Close coordination is being done at every level with the state and local authorities and police forces to ensure safety and security during distribution.
- The state and the Demand Creation team have started going on media (radio and television) to inform the people that state is planning on how to attend to people in uncovered settlements;
 - In addition, a protocol should be prepared indicating how/when the State will cover, after distribution, the settlements and HHs that have been partially or not covered; And, for the DP Teams to follow, on how to manage/proceed/inform HHs that show up at the DP but have not received Net Cards and/or not previously registered;

- Matthieu A. AAWI Programme National de Lutte contre le Paludisme (PNLP Togo) shared his experience on the call today of AMP mentoring exercice in Chad
- Presentation in English and French attached to the minutes of this week's call
- A new approach to mentoring is possible within the framework of the UNOPS funding available under RBM and is being explored and was discussed in more detail for integration into the AMP workplan during the AMP core group meeting held in August 2019.
- The idea is to identify an NMCP representative with a specific skill set (e.g. electronic data collection) and have them join an AMP mission. This would allow the person to gain the experience of AMP and our approach to working, facilitate cross-country learning and exchange of experience.
- The UNOPS funding can cover travel and mission expenses on these types of country exchange missions.
- During the first half of 2019, it has been decided to test this approach and to include the current logistician from Togo to support the AMP mission focusing on logistics in Chad in April 2019.
- It is a capacity building process through practical training which will enable Togo to have their own expert in logistics for future use in advance of their planned 2020 campaign.
- The TA provider was trained during this mission by developing some of the macro planning documents that are required for Chad (and which can then be adapted to Togo) and was mentored by the AMP TA team lead who has both implementation and logistics capacity to build the logistician's skillset further.
- Going forward there is a need to consider whether some kind of a standard reporting format for this specific type of mission will be developed and what do we wish to learn from it.
