Monitoring, Operational Research, and Evaluation (MORE) working group:

- Call was held with EIWG to discuss synergies on issues of both working groups
- Minutes will be shared with AMP core group to present proposal on moving forward with issues.
- **Issues with retooling guidance on HH registration**
- Everyone acknowledges that there are problems with household registration (most of these problems are consistent across countries, though there may be a few outliers here and there).
- People have ideas for how to improve it, but we need to pull together those ideas (e.g. if you pay more, is it better; if you collect loads of data, is it better; if you outsource it, is it better; is it higher quality using people recruited from the community or people from outside the community; etc.) in order to be able to move the discussion forward.
- If we can identify some key operations research questions that need to be addressed around potential efficiencies and improvements in quality, we can then pitch these to different partners and donors and look to collect data on what actually works and what doesn’t.
- It is critical that AMP starts to get ahead of this issue
- We should identify key partners that we could pull together for a technical call on this specific issue to try to brainstorm some of the questions that need to be answered and identify a way forward.

Update on October 9th AMP conference call:

- Burundi has now decided to move forward with a one phase campaign to be completed before the end of 2019
- Les microplans sont compilés et les synthèses disponibles et partagées
 - Synthèse des microplans transport pour PAM ;
 - Synthèse des microplans districts pour les ABC,
 - Synthèse des quantifications des outils-districts,
 - Synthèse générale des microplans
- Suite à la micro-planification, la synthèse du budget des activités est en cours ;
- La formation des superviseurs nationaux a été réalisée du 02 au 04 octobre,
- Il y a incertitudes sur la production et livraison des outils de gestion de la campagne pour la plupart des provinces (seules deux auraient déjà reçu)
- Incertitudes sur le production/livraison des supports de communication ;
- Formation des agents de saisie : initialement prévue lors de la formation des dénombreurs et superviseurs de proximité, finalement programmée pour une session spéciale mais planifiée à J2 du dénombrement sur les données réelles (les SIS des CDS étant regroupés chez les SIS du District pour une saisie en temps réel comme méthode de formation).
- Système de paiement par téléphonie mobile confirmé par PNUD, mais listes des acteurs non encore parvenue au PNUD (CARITAS n’ayant pas encore transmis pour retard accusé dans la complétude et la correction des listes) ;

- Programmation de la CDM et le chronogramme des activités, dates de dénombrement et distribution sont toujours en discussion selon réalités de mise en œuvre sur le terrain

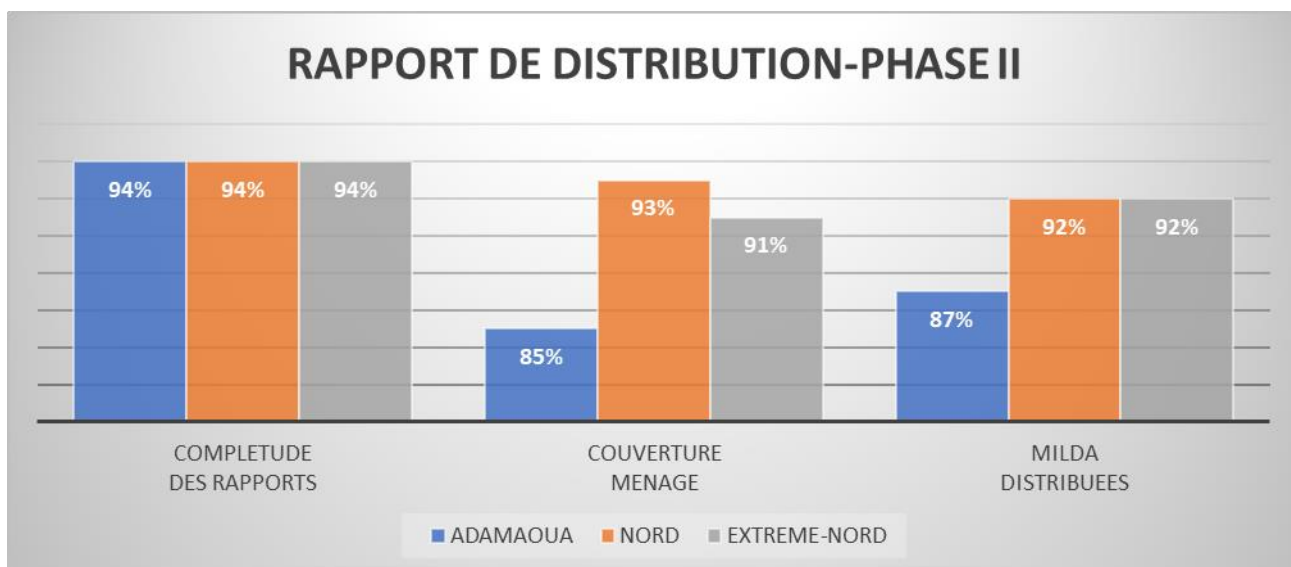
Ongoing issues :

Résultat de la distribution dans l'Extrême-Nord

- La distribution des MILDA aux ménages dénombrés dans le cadre de la Campagne de distribution des MILDA avait été prévu, dans la région de l'Extrême-Nord, durant la période allant du 19-23 septembre 2019. Après une distribution des MILDA de 5 jours, il a été recommandé de prolonger la période de distribution de 2 jours pour un ratissage.
- Il est à souligner que cette première phase n'a concerné que 14 districts sur les 30 de la région.
- Les résultats provisoires à J5 se présentent de la manière suivante :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
 - 91% de couverture des ménages attendus.
 - 92% des MILDA distribuées.
- Durant les deux jours de ratissage, il a été recommandé de se rassurer que les équipes de distribution informent les ménages restants par téléphone et si possible avec l'appui du crieur.

Résultat de la distribution dans le Nord et Adamaoua

- Etant donné que certaines aires de santé des régions d'Adamaoua et du Nord ont démarré leur distribution en retard due à un retard d'acheminement des MILDA, dès le démarrage de ces aires de santé les résultats se présentent de la manière suivante en ce jour :
- La région de l'Adamaoua :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
 - 85% de couverture des ménages attendus.
 - 87% des MILDA distribuées.
- La région du Nord :
- 94% des rapports de distribution des aires sont disponibles à ce jour, avec :
 - 93% de couverture des ménages attendus.
 - 92% des MILDA distribuées.

Difficultés rencontrées :

- Gap des MILDA par rapport aux besoins du dénombrement des ménages.
- Rupture de stock au niveau de plusieurs sites de distribution.
- Problèmes de remplissage des outils au niveau des sites de distribution.
- Faiblesse de communication au niveau du site de distribution.
- Problème de supervision avec absence régulière des superviseurs surtout des aires de santé
- Non-paiement des crieurs pour la phase de dénombrement des ménages.
- Le retard de paiement de la CPS (2 séries) démoralise les superviseurs.

Ongoing issues:

- Matthieu A. AAWI - Programme National de Lutte contre le Paludisme (PNLP Togo) shared his experience on the call today of AMP mentoring exercise in Chad
- Presentation in English and French attached to the minutes of this week's call
- A new approach to mentoring is possible within the framework of the UNOPS funding available under RBM and is being explored and was discussed in more detail for integration into the AMP workplan during the AMP core group meeting held in August 2019.
- The idea is to identify an NMCP representative with a specific skill set (e.g. electronic data collection) and have them join an AMP mission. This would allow the person to gain the experience of AMP and our approach to working, facilitate cross-country learning and exchange of experience.
- The UNOPS funding can cover travel and mission expenses on these types of country exchange missions.
- During the first half of 2019, it has been decided to test this approach and to include the current logistician from Togo to support the AMP mission focusing on logistics in Chad in April 2019.
- It is a capacity building process through practical training which will enable Togo to have their own expert in logistics for future use in advance of their planned 2020 campaign.
- The TA provider was trained during this mission by developing some of the macro planning documents that are required for Chad (and which can then be adapted to Togo) and was mentored by the AMP TA team lead who has both implementation and logistics capacity to build the logistician's skillset further.
- Going forward there is a need to consider whether some kind of a standard reporting format for this specific type of mission will be developed and what do we wish to learn from it.
