**Update on September 11th AMP conference call:**

- Overall, the activities of the NMCP are being implemented in all districts of the country. Now in the third round of the Seasonal Malaria Chemoprevention (SMC) campaign from 18 to 21 September.
- Dialogue between the Government and the trade unions is continuing around the strike - hope to be able to take stock of the first phase in the weeks / months to come and to be able to conduct phase 2 with lessons learned
- With regard to planning for Phase 2, preparations are continuing, taking practical steps to incorporate Phase 1 recommendations wherever possible. In particular - include house to house messaging that HHs should not send children under the age of 15 to distribution sites to collect ITNs.
- Preparing for process evaluation mission: the more in-depth the interviews are, the more we will obtain relevant elements of analysis to enrich the report and in turn give better recommendations.
- Phase 2 is IG2 distribution
- Agreeing on process evaluation ToRs and mission dates based on net arrival dates

**Update on September 11th AMP conference call:**

- Information on malaria epidemic will be shared on a focus call likely to take place in 2-3 weeks' time
- Potentially moving the distribution schedule ahead
- Proposing to have the distribution in Oct/Nov in accordance with times of arrival of nets in country – phased out according to net delivery.
- To be discussed and AMP to provide advice on acceleration distribution
- GF has been in touch with AMP to discuss strategy and timeline modifications
- 2 WHO staff assigned to Burundi should be arriving today

- Epidemic now involves entire country population including in high altitude where malaria was no longer present
- 1.5 million additional drugs coming
- Not sure yet if it will be possible to have distribution before the rains start.
- Coordination between partners is challenging
- Nets (just under 7 million) are supposed to arrive in late September but experience shows consistent delays in arrivals, we might need to put pressure on the supplier.
- One province is getting PBO nets, others are getting standard nets.

**Update on September 11th AMP conference call:**

- AMP TA providers have arrived in country and travelled to Adamaoua
- Weekly situation report attached to the minutes of this week's call
- Cameroon is planning to implement a third mass campaign in 2019. It is planned to distribute 14,697,104 LLINs with standard PBO and LLINs
- 10 931 571 nets will be financed by the GF and 3 765 533 LLINs will be financed by the Cameroonian government.
- Phase 1 was carried out in the period from 13 to 19 June 2019 with 2 days of catch up. The results gave a 90% distribution of LLINs with 89.7% coverage
- The country is now preparing Phase 2 with the Adamawa and North regions. In parallel the HH registration is also being prepared in Extreme-North.
- Adamawa distribution is scheduled from 05 to 09 September 2019
- For the North, distribution is scheduled from September 12 to 16, 2019
- For the preparation of the campaign in the Far North, the mitigation plan was discussed, and the following points retained:
- Micro-planning: Proposal of the number of days of the micro-planning workshop with an additional day.
- HH registration: Proposals to review the number of days of household registration and review the workload of the teams.
- Distribution of LLINs: agree that we cannot go with the standard strategy and two approaches are suggested according to the mapping of security risks:
  1. District with proven insecurity: " Hit and Run " strategy
  2. Districts in more or less acceptable security: standard strategy:
- HH registration for 5 days
- Distribution for 3 days with fixed and mobile distribution sites



- Communication activities begin with the launch of this phase 2 of the campaign which is scheduled for September 5 in urban Ngaoundere - insufficient number of days for the town criers noted
- Training of health area supervisors is completed for all districts however training of distributors will not be available for all health areas as LLINs are not available in all areas yet.
- For logistics, the regional store has been empty since August 29, 2019 and LLINs are being positioned in the health areas. 72 out of 88 areas are fully serviced to date.
- The district of Tignere have only 2 fully served areas, 1 partially served area and 9 areas not yet served.
- The district of Bagne has 7 areas served out of 11. The region has no information on the situation of the trucks that are on hold - season of heavy rains ongoing
- The distribution in the district of Tignere will be on September 12, 2019.

**Update on September 11th AMP conference call:**

- National entomology review meeting held late August. Principal investigators across the 16 sentinel sites provided update on insecticide resistance monitoring from their sites. This has implication for the deployment of nets for campaigns and continuous distribution in Nigeria. ITNs will only be deployed based on result of insecticide resistance monitoring.
- USAID/PMI malaria operational planning is on ongoing in Nigeria. PMI has indicated it will continue to support the triennial mass campaigns in its supported States. State will now play a critical role in providing LLINs for continuous distribution in their states.
- The Nigeria ITN campaign guidelines have been ratified by the IVM subcommittee and is now in use by all campaign implementers in Nigeria. It is being reviewed for further typographical errors after which it will be transmitted for Ministerial endorsements.
- Ebonyi state mass campaign is slated to commence on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019. Over 1.7 million nets to be distributed.
- PMI have procured 3.1 million nets for Zamfara LLIN campaign. Microplanning will be in December with implementation in March 2020.
- Over 3.5 million nets are to be procured for Benue LLIN campaign. The procurement process is delayed by colour preference issues in the State.
- 5 million nets to be procured for Oyo State. There is possibly going to be a combination of PBO and other nets deployed within the state.
- There have been a change in the leadership of the ITN expert group in Nigeria. Godwin Aidenagbon have been nominated to lead the expert group.
- Kano State (GF funded) has commenced and doing training of HH mobilisers. HH reg starts Saturday
- Last GF funded state campaign is Niger State in 2019

**Update on September 11th AMP conference call:**

- AMP TA in-country mission is complete – new TA going in soon
- Pakistan implemented a successful campaign in 2018, despite a number of challenges linked to updated approaches. The Directorate of Malaria Control (DOMC) and The Indus Hospital (TIH) in partnership with the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent (IFRC) through the Pakistan Red Crescent Society (PRCS) as funded by the Global Fund is planning to implement the distribution of 3.1m ITNs in 23 districts of Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK) including the Tribal Areas. The strategy adopted in the distribution of ITN was to achieve universal coverage with ITN in the targeted rural areas where the latest surveillance data revealed high malaria Endemicity.
- Pakistan incurred a significant delay in the campaign due to different reasons. Given the delay in the campaign, there is a very tight timeline to get everything done so that we don't miss the high transmission season. This support is also to ensure that there is sufficient capacity to manage the different issues raised previously in the OIG report, in particular accountability for the nets in the supply chain. The 2019 campaign is targeting some of the most insecure areas of the country.

**Update on September 11th AMP conference call:**

- Campaign is planned for April 2020 start up, with micro planning in January
- AMP will review documents as soon as possible to facilitate final submission.
- Procurement has been completed and delivery of ITNs from both funding partners is expected in February-March 2020 in line with the campaign timeline that has been established. All nets will be delivered to the districts (or regional warehouses) as per the planning established.
- There is a gap of 1.8M USD for the operational costs for the campaign. PMI is working with partners to fill the gap. Work is ongoing with DfID to see if they can cover the gap and this looks promising. DfID would flow funds through UNICEF based on an existing agreement.
- Funding needs to be in place by end of October in order for activities to begin (such as warehouse assessments) according to the campaign timeline.
- The budget has been finalized and activities allocated to UNICEF. The DMOs were briefed on the changes for the 2020 mass campaign in terms of finance and procurement.
- The IHPAU framework agreement is in place, including for district level procurement of transportation and warehousing.
- The documents developed during the AMP finance TA mission have been reviewed by NMCP and inputs included.
- SBCC plan has been finalized. One additional activity has been added for engaging the Sierra Leone football association. Currently, this activity has a lump sum in the budget.
- Vouchers will be procured through IHPAU and the framework agreement in place includes this.
- NMCP to finalize the voucher design to allow timely procurement.
- Rapid monitoring protocol has been reviewed by CDC - The protocol will need to be reworked based on scope and scale, methodology and data collection (electronic or paper). There are insufficient electronic data collection devices for the rapid monitoring and it is not recommended to use separate systems, so this needs to be taken into account. Statistics Sierra Leone could be engaged (other countries use the national statistics office to do this activity).
- The campaign will be integrated, including Vitamin A and albendazole. The training and data collection tools will need to be reviewed, as will the microplanning templates.
- Commodities to be integrated will be procured by the Direction of Nutrition. The campaign will still maintain separate household registration and ITN distribution phases as per the campaign plan of action.

- NMCP will review if there is a need for any additional TA before the microplanning mission in January and send feedback to AMP.

**Ongoing issues:**

- Matthieu A. AAWI - Programme National de Lutte contre le Paludisme (PNLP Togo) shared his experience on the call today of AMP mentoring exercise in Chad
- Presentation in English and French attached to the minutes of this week's call
- A new approach to mentoring is possible within the framework of the UNOPS funding available under RBM and is being explored and was discussed in more detail for integration into the AMP workplan during the AMP core group meeting held in August 2019.
- The idea is to identify an NMCP representative with a specific skill set (e.g. electronic data collection) and have them join an AMP mission. This would allow the person to gain the experience of AMP and our approach to working, facilitate cross-country learning and exchange of experience.
- The UNOPS funding can cover travel and mission expenses on these types of country exchange missions.
- During the first half of 2019, it has been decided to test this approach and to include the current logistician from Togo to support the AMP mission focusing on logistics in Chad in April 2019.
- It is a capacity building process through practical training which will enable Togo to have their own expert in logistics for future use in advance of their planned 2020 campaign.
- The TA provider was trained during this mission by developing some of the macro planning documents that are required for Chad (and which can then be adapted to Togo) and was mentored by the AMP TA team lead who has both implementation and logistics capacity to build the logistician's skillset further.
- Going forward there is a need to consider whether some kind of a standard reporting format for this specific type of mission will be developed and what do we wish to learn from it.
