- Call was held with EIWG to discuss synergies on issues of both working groups
- Minutes will be shared with AMP core group to present proposal on moving forward with issues.
- **Issues with retooling guidance on HH registration**
- Everyone acknowledges that there are problems with household registration (most of these problems are consistent across countries, though there may be a few outliers here and there).
- People have ideas for how to improve it, but we need to pull together those ideas (e.g. if you pay more, is it better; if you collect loads of data, is it better; if you outsource it, is it better; is it higher quality using people recruited from the community or people from outside the community; etc.) in order to be able to move the discussion forward.
- If we can identify some key operations research questions that need to be addressed around potential efficiencies and improvements in quality, we can then pitch these to different partners and donors and look to collect data on what actually works and what doesn’t.
- It is critical that AMP starts to get ahead of this issue
- We should identify key partners that we could pull together for a technical call on this specific issue to try to brainstorm some of the questions that need to be answered and identify a way forward.

**Update on September 18th AMP conference call:**

- Overall, the activities of the NMCP are being implemented in all districts of the country. Now in the third round of the Seasonal Malaria Chemoprevention (SMC) campaign from 18 to 21 September.
- Preparing for process evaluation mission: the more in-depth the interviews are, the more we will obtain relevant elements of analysis to enrich the report and in turn give better recommendations.
- Phase 2 is IG2 distribution
- Process evaluation ToRs have been finalised and shared with PNL
- AMP is also proposing an observation mission for the country team in Mali to be able to learn from the IG2 distribution in Burkina as they will be conducting their own distribution in 2020.
- Timing of BF to be aligned with Rwanda end of October

**Update on September 18th AMP conference call:**

- USAID/PMI malaria operational planning completed in Abuja. PMI has indicated it will continue to support the triennial mass campaigns in its supported States. State will now play a critical role in providing LLINs for continuous distribution in their states.
- Ebonyi state mass campaign is slated to commence on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019. Over 1.7 million nets to be distributed.
- PMI have procured 3.1 million nets for Zamfara LLIN campaign. Microplanning will be in December with implementation in March 2020.
- Over 3.5 million nets are to be procured for Benue LLIN campaign. The procurement process is delayed by colour preference issues in the State.
- 5 million nets to be procured for Oyo State. There is possibly going to be a combination of PBO and other nets deployed within the state.
- Last GF funded state campaign is Niger State in 2019 – some delays in net arrivals but campaign timelines should still not change
- Kano State campaign is ongin and HH registration is happening now – AMP TA sitrep attached to the minutes of this week’s call
- Kano is the most populated state in the country.
- LLIN quantification was estimated using the projected population for 2018 (from 2006 census) divided by 1.8 to provide 1 net for every 2 people (in line with WHO recommendations) rounding up for households with uneven number and a cap of four (4) LLINs per household.
- Catholic Relief Services is Co-PR with the National Malaria Elimination Program (NMEP), on the Global Fund Malaria Grant.
- CRS provide oversight function to Society for Family Health, SFH, a Nigerian national NGO, that is the SR, in charge of Kano campaign training and implementation.
- The Kano campaigns is implemented using the National LLIN Operational manual and Cash and Asset Transfer (CAT) Strategy which involves use of mobile phones for process optimization.
- Based on microplanning, 3160 fixed and 404 satellite Distribution Points have been identified to serve the population in the 484 wards of the 44 Local Government Areas (LGAs).
- In preparation for the household mobilization over 11,000 mobilizers were recruited and trained in 145 locations trough out the state.
- 5782 android devices were purchased and are currently used in the registration process.
- **Mission Objectives:** Provide overall technical assistance to NMEP/CRS/SFH during the campaign in Kano State
  - Monitor and evaluate the use of technology,
  - Review the campaign strategy/model,
  - Share lessons and best practices,
  - Make recommendations for improving Campaign processes and outcomes.

**Ongoing issues:**

- Matthieu A. AAWI - Programme National de Lutte contre le Paludisme (PNLP Togo) shared his experience on the call today of AMP mentoring exercise in Chad
- Presentation in English and French attached to the minutes of this week's call
- A new approach to mentoring is possible within the framework of the UNOPS funding available under RBM and is being explored and was discussed in more detail for integration into the AMP workplan during the AMP core group meeting held in August 2019.
- The idea is to identify an NMCP representative with a specific skill set (e.g. electronic data collection) and have them join an AMP mission. This would allow the person to gain the experience of AMP and our approach to working, facilitate cross-country learning and exchange of experience.
- The UNOPS funding can cover travel and mission expenses on these types of country exchange missions.
- During the first half of 2019, it has been decided to test this approach and to include the current logistician from Togo to support the AMP mission focusing on logistics in Chad in April 2019.
- It is a capacity building process through practical training which will enable Togo to have their own expert in logistics for future use in advance of their planned 2020 campaign.
- The TA provider was trained during this mission by developing some of the macro planning documents that are required for Chad (and which can then be adapted to Togo) and was mentored by the AMP TA team lead who has both implementation and logistics capacity to build the logistician's skillset further.
- Going forward there is a need to consider whether some kind of a standard reporting format for this specific type of mission will be developed and what do we wish to learn from it.
