Your new nets are very valuable for protecting you from the bites of malaria mosquitos while you are in bed.

In order to be protected, you should hang your new nets up right away, that is, after airing them in the shade for an entire day.

The old nets that they replace can still be useful, not for sleeping under, but for helping to keep mosquitoes out of your house/home.

Use the old nets as screens on your window openings or on your doorways to help keep mosquitoes and other annoying insects out.

You can also use old nets to fill holes in the roof or walls where mosquitoes might enter your home.

Once you have protected yourself and your home from mosquitoes, and if you still have some old nets, feel free to use these in the garden to protect your plants or cage chickens.

Never use old or new nets for fishing.

And never burn old nets. Burning the nets releases poisons into the air that are harmful to people and animals.
